**Knights of Columbus Meeting Minutes for June 14, 2018** – The Council was called to order by GK Roger Siebenaler at 7:03pm. Prayers were offered by the Grand Knight along with the Pledge of Allegiance. Officers present:

**Treasurer's Report** – Maurie reported a checking account Balance of 3255.81 and a savings account balance of 2142.14

**Financial Secretary's report** – Greg Neau was not in attendance but did send a summary of financial information to Roger Siebenaler who reported it at the meeting. It showed Revenues from May 10 thru June 14 as follows Bkfst \$513, Raffle Proceeds \$135 Dues Collected \$7224 for a total Revenue \$1372.

Expenses reported were: Brkfst Supplies \$236.74 St Joachim Youth Fund \$200, Supplies for Future (Tootsie Rolls) \$184 St Vincent De Paul \$100 for a total \$720.74 Net Revenue: 651.26

**Chaplain's Report** – None

**Unfinished Business:** The KC Vocation Scholarship Idea was discussed. Greg Neau had met with Fr Becker previously on this issue and had some idea's to share but was unable to make the meeting. Done Dose moved and Steve Schouweiler seconded a motion to table the issue until next meeting. Motion Passed (Tom Deming abstained)

**New Business:** Roger Siebenaler had been approached from a member about giving an additional notification of the meeting dates just prior to the meeting (in addition to the monthly newsletter). Roger was going to look into the process/cost of an automatic call procedure and report at a future meeting. Another option discussed was sending out email notifications just prior to the meeting dates (we have email address on about 85% of the members)

A Social event is planned for July 15 (Sunday at Noon) for Knights of Columbus and Catholic Daughters members, spouses and families. It would include grilled burgers and brats, potato salad and beans. The KCs would pay the cost of this which is estimated to be about \$3.50 per person. This will be communicated to the membership of the two group with RSVPs requested by July 11. Motion made to approve by Jerome Schmidt, Seconded by Don Dose and passed.

Elections were held for KC officers. Don Dose made a motion, seconded by Maurie Young and passed to cast a unanimous ballot for the following slate of officers (See sidebar on next page). Motion passed unanimously. Greg Neau's position as financial secretary is appointed and he is in the second year of a 3 year term.

**Closing Prayers** were led by Grand Knight Roger Seibenaler and meeting adjourned at 8:08pm
