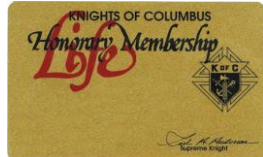

Knights of Columbus Meeting Minutes for July 12, 2018 – The Council was called to order by GK Jerome Schmidt at 7:00 pm. Prayers were offered by the Grand Knight along with the Pledge of Allegiance. Officers present:

Last Month's Minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report – Presented by Jerome on behalf of Maurie Young Checking Balance \$3041.56 and savings account balance \$2142.40

Financial Secretary's report – Greg Neau reported income of \$25 since last meeting and expenses of \$239.25 for a net reduction of \$214.25.

Fraternal Year totals: (July 1,2017-June 30,2018) income: \$5583.75 Expense: 523.22 for a net increase of \$330.53.

Semi Annual Audit completed for Aug 2018. Thank you letters received for donations to St Vincent De Paul and St Joachim Youth Fund.

District Deputy Report – Kevin O'Laughlin reported on the state meeting and indicated that the audit was due in the near future. There will be a district meeting in Winona on July 31st. the 4 Themes /programs that the KCs will be pursuing are: Faith/Community/Life and Family – They hope to be more spiritually focused and will be centered on asking the pastor "what can we do for you?"

Safe Environment training are needed with training on-line for the following positions: Grand Knight, Program Director, Family Director, Community Director

There is a movement to seupt on-line memberships for millennials to join the Knights.

Chaplain's Report – Fr Becker gave his talk on VOCATIONS DISCERNMEN especially for seminarians. The seminary is located at St Mary's College Campus in Winona. They typically start with 40 -50 men who are college students (Called College Seminarians) . The group typically drops 30-40 Men after discernment at the college level. Their first year training is mainly on philosophy but they also can major in other areas. Then it is 4 years there and then to theology school for 4 or 5 more years. If you went into the seminary with a college degree, you would probably need 2 more years of Philosophy.

Minutes – Continued Unfinished Business –

- 1) Grand Knight Schmidt thanked Roger Siebenaler for his years of service as the grand knight.
- 2) Grand Knight thanked Dennis Bronk for his years of service as Bingo Chairman. This is a position that the GK hopes to find a volunteer to continue this program.
- 3) The vocation scholarship was discussed. It was decided to adopt the basic plan that was outlined in last month’s newsletter. It included matching funds up to \$1,000 for donations that come in and are targeted for Vince Deming. Don Dose made a motion seconded by Roger Siebenaler with the details to match the program outlined in the July 2018 Newsletter. Motion Passed with Tom Deming abstaining.
 Greg Neau is going to review the rules of the RSVP program that could potentially get a rebate from the Supreme of \$100 for every \$500 spent in support of a religious vocation or priest.
 Example Described : If \$6000 is donated to the scholarship, \$1000 of matching funds would go to Vince right away and \$6000.00 would be paid upon his professing vows. It was also suggested that the funds be paid quarterly as they are collected
- 4) It was decided to cancel the July 22nd KC/Catholic Daughters social event due to minimal signups/interest.
