The Chicken Dinner will be served take out style with indoor seating available in St. Anne's Hall and outdoor seating (weather permitting) from 11:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. with a menu of grilled chicken, mashed potatoes and gravy, coleslaw, dinner roll, homemade pie and a beverage.
